

Information Clause of the Competition

Fulfilment of the information obligation in relation to the requirements set forth in the Article 13 of the **Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)** (hereinafter: GDPR)

The Philharmonic acting in the capacity of the data Controller informs that it processes personal data under GDPR Article 6 Section 1 letters a, f on the basis of an expressed consent and in a legitimate interest of the Controller. The personal data forwarded to the Philharmonic shall be used exclusively for the purposes of and in the scope of the organisation of the Competition. Providing personal data is voluntary; however, a refusal to provide them shall render it impossible to take part in the Competition. The Controller's legitimate business covers marketing activities and archiving of the personal data. Please, be advised that you have the right to access your personal data, to limit the data processing, to erase, to rectify, and to transfer your personal data. Furthermore, you have the right to revoke your consent with no effect on the processing carried out before the consent is revoked.

Your data will be made available or transferred to entities authorised under a relevant legal regulation or to co-organisers, other entities to which the Controller has entrusted the data to be processed. In particular, the recipients of the data can be the Marshal Office of the Province of Silesia, the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage, the National Institute of Music and Dance, and other entities co-organising the Competition.

The data will be also made available to entities securing appropriate operation of websites, to addressees of the Controller's marketing content, to YouTube users, as well as to Google, the owner of YouTube. In connection with the data transfer to the USA through YouTube, please, be advised that it shall be carried out in compliance with the provisions of GDPR Chapter V, based on standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission. In order to exercise the rights resulting from GDPR Articles 15-22, use the form available in the Google Privacy Policy.

You have the right to file a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office for the Controller's manner of data processing. The data shall be processed until the purposes of the processing cease or the consent is revoked. Providing personal data is voluntary, but indispensable for the implementation of the defined objectives.
